

Medicaid Transportation information

Unlimited rides available for any patient that is on dialysis, is wheelchair bound, or lives greater than 30 miles from appointment. Patients that need to be seen within the scheduling window may have urgent transportation arranged by someone in the office.

*For quickest return trip call number for insurance company and not driver that dropped off patient

- 30 one way rides call 3 business days before
- Bus pass can be requested, 3 or more appointments in one month can request a month bus pass that will count as 2 trips
- Will take patient to pharmacy or lab/diagnostics after an appointment
- Additional rides can be requested by calling and filling out a form

Buckeye 1-866-246-4358

- 30 one way rides call 48 hours in advance
- Bus pass can be requested, also 48 hours in advance
- Will take patient to pharmacy after an appointment
- Additional rides can be requested by calling and filling out a form

Molina 1-866-642-9279

- 30 one way rides call 48 hours in advance
- Will take patient to pharmacy after an appointment
- Additional rides can be requested by calling and filling out a form

Paramount 1-866-837-9817

- 30 one way rides call 72 hours in advance
- Bus pass can be requested
- If more than 30 rides are needed, must go through Job and Family Services non-emergent medical transport program
